Our readers include lawyers, judges, academicians, writing instructors, and a wide range of others interested in improving legal writing.

**Submissions.** Please e-mail manuscripts to Megan Boyd at [mboyd7@gsu.edu](mailto:mboyd7@gsu.edu). Word documents are preferred. We have no minimum or maximum page count.

**Style.** For grammar and usage, follow *Garner's Dictionary of Legal Usage* (3d ed. 2011) and *Garner's Modern American Usage* (3d ed. 2009). For citations, follow the *ALWD Guide to Legal Citation* (5<sup>th</sup> ed. 2014) or *The Bluebook: A Uniform System of Citation* (20<sup>th</sup> ed. 2015). For spelling, follow *Merriam-Webster's Collegiate Dictionary* (11<sup>th</sup> ed. 2003). We discourage footnotes that contain substantive discussion; footnotes used to cite pertinent materials are fully acceptable.

**Editorial Policy.** We evaluate manuscripts for their interest, significance, originality, and style. We edit selected manuscripts for clarity, concision, and accuracy.

**Contributors' Responsibilities.** By submitting a manuscript, each contributor warrants that he or she has obtained all necessary copyright permissions for quoted materials. Contributors are responsible for the accuracy of all quotations and citations.

**Copyright.** Unless otherwise noted, the copyright of each piece published in the *Journal* belongs to Scribes. But contributors are free to use their own material if they duly acknowledge *The Scribes Journal of Legal Writing*.
